## Luke 22:1-23 (NASB)

A<sup>1</sup> Now the Feast of Unleavened Bread, which is called the Passover, was approaching. <sup>2</sup> The chief priests and the scribes were **seeking** (*zēteō*) how they might put Him to death; for they were afraid of the people.

B<sup>3</sup> And Satan **entered** into Judas who was called Iscariot, belonging to the number of the twelve.

C<sup>4</sup> And he went away and discussed with the chief priests and officers how he might **betray** Him to them.

<sup>5</sup> They were glad and agreed to give him money. <sup>6</sup> So he consented, and began seeking a good opportunity to betray Him to them apart from the crowd.

D<sup>7</sup> Then came the first day of Unleavened Bread on which **the Passover lamb had to be sacrificed**. <sup>8</sup> And Jesus sent Peter and John, saying, “Go and prepare the Passover for us, so that we may eat it.” <sup>9</sup> They said to Him, “Where do You want us to prepare it?”

<sup>10</sup> And He said to them, “When you have entered the city, a man will meet you carrying a pitcher of water; follow him into the house that he enters. <sup>11</sup> And you shall say to the owner of the house, ‘The Teacher says to you, “Where is the guest room in which I may eat the Passover with My disciples?’” <sup>12</sup> And he will show you a large, furnished upper room; prepare it there.” <sup>13</sup> And they left and found everything just as

He had told them; and they prepared the Passover.

E<sup>14</sup> When the hour had come, He reclined at the table, and the apostles with Him. <sup>15</sup> And He said to them, “I have earnestly desired to eat this **Passover with you before I suffer; F<sup>16</sup> for I say to you, I shall never again eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God.”**

X<sup>17</sup> And **when He had taken a cup and given thanks**, He said, “Take this and share it among yourselves; F<sup>18</sup> for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine from now on until the kingdom of God comes.”

E<sup>19</sup> And when He had taken some bread and given thanks, He broke it and gave it to them, saying, “This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me.”

D<sup>20</sup> And in the same way He took the cup after they had eaten, saying, “This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood.”

C<sup>21</sup> But behold, the hand of the one **betraying Me** is with Mine on the table.

B<sup>22</sup> For indeed, the Son of Man is **going** as it has been determined; but woe to that man by whom He is betrayed!”

A<sup>23</sup> And they began to **discuss** (*syzēteō*) among themselves which one of them it might be who was going to do this thing.
