Luke 19:11b (ESV)

The Parable That Jesus Told:

I. A nobleman entrusts to ten servants, one mina each, and then goes away to receive a kingdom for himself (vv. 11-13)
II. His subjects sends a delegation to prevent him from obtaining his kingship. (v. 14)
III. The nobleman returns as king and calls his servants to account for the mina entrusted & rewards/penalises each accordingly (vv. 15-26)
IV. The king orders the destruction of his subjects who had rejected him. (v. 27)
