

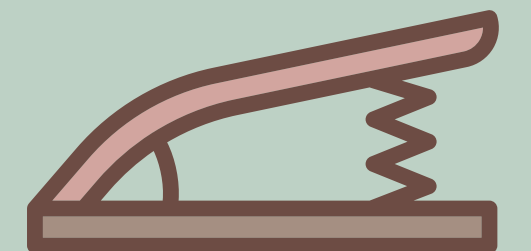

What is SPRINGBOARD?

CBC's adult **discipleship course** to develop a good **foundation** for Calvinians to grow in their Christian faith, by:

- grounding themselves in a **systematic understanding of core doctrines** (the most important teachings and beliefs of Christianity)
- **nurture life-long spiritual habits** of bible-reading and meditation and theological reflection
- **build spiritual friendships** with a committed group of Calvinians over a period of time

CBC Spiritual Growth Roadmap

“I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth.” - 1 Corinthians 3:6 (ESV)



Why **SPRINGBOARD**?

- **Discipleship** - the continued commitment to follow our Master Jesus
- **Journey** as individuals and a community **to grow toward Christlikeness** or "the fullness of Christ" (Ephesians 4:13)
 - A growing knowledge of the gospel →
 - A growing desire to know and love Christ →
 - A growing surrender to follow Him - "in denying ourselves, taking up our cross and following Him" (Luke 9:23)

Why SPRINGBOARD?

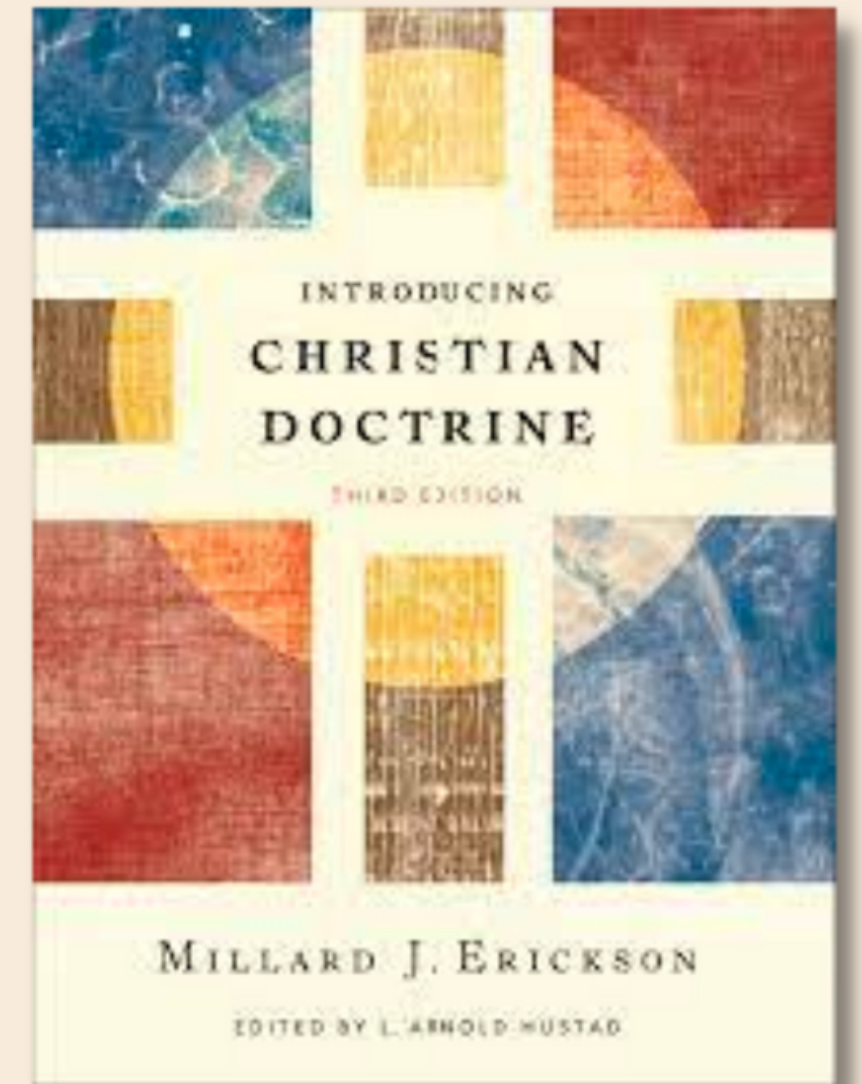
- **Purpose of Christian Education Ministry**
 - "to present every Calvinian mature in Christ" (Colossians 1:28)
 - Not just knowledge transfer, but facilitating and nurturing affections
- SPRINGBOARD therefore hopes to **develop and nurture a foundation that can help 'springboard' Calvinians to being able to grow inter-dependently!**
 - Developing / deepening roots
 - Staying rooted in Christ and His Church

Course Overview

- Pilot Run: 5 March - 16 July 2022
- 20 weeks (17 weeks of learning with week breaks in-between)
- Hybrid, Flipped-Classroom Approach
 - individual Bible readings and study (online)
 - small-group discussions, reflections and prayer time (online or in-person)
 - large-group talks and Q&A (in-person)

Course Overview

- Covering through a Systematic Theology topical outline
- Each week:
 - **Individual Study**
 - Learning through reading and meditating on bible passages related to the topic (10 mins x 5 days)
 - Summary Teaching Points regarding topics covered for the week
 - At least 1 supplementary material per week



Course Overview

- Each week:
 - Either **Small Group Discussion** (~40-60 mins, online or in-person)
 - Meet in your group of 2-3 to share lessons from the week's reading
 - Discuss group reflection questions provided and work on submission due Sunday night
 - Share prayer requests and pray for one another
 - Submission: group reflection on online classroom (find out what other small groups think, interact with one another's reflections)

Course Overview

- or **Live Talk and Q&A** (90 mins, in-person)
 - Meet cohort for live talk related to topics covered in past weeks
 - Q&A for anything that arose in self-study or small group discussions
 - Submission: individual reflection on your takeaways from past weeks and live talk (private submission)
- Ongoing - **Online Classroom:**
 - Interaction with facilitators and other participants on the online classroom platform

Course Requirements

- Open to all Calvarians (over 18 years of age) who are:
 - Committed to following Jesus as their Lord and Saviour
 - Willing to commit to participating fully in the course activities and assignments in the 20 weeks
 - Desire to continue in the spiritual habits and the journey of spiritual growth in the Calvary community during and after the course
- As this is the pilot run of the course, we would also greatly appreciate participants who can be patient and open to give feedback on how we can improve on the future runs of the course. :)

Course Expectations

- Participants to understand that SPRINGBOARD **does not** make you Christian or a better Christian, but provides space and resources to help to grow to be more Christ-like
- Participants are encouraged to be actively engaged in the church community while on this discipleship journey:
 - Attending Sunday services every week (most preferably in-person)
 - In a CG and attending regularly
 - Serving in ministry in some capacity
 - Participate in P&P

Course Expectations

- Participants are encouraged to
 - make the course a priority (in daily Bible readings, small group and large group engagements) as much as possible
 - be willing and open to share with fellow participants
 - be self-motivated in actively learning directly from the Bible and with fellow Christians
 - be thoughtful and reflective about implications of topics and theology learnt, and how they should be applied to their individual lives
